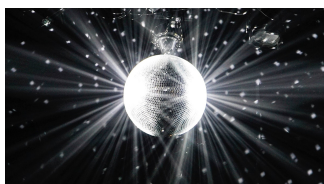
After 'The Letter' - Parish Proposed Action Plans
