Donations and Gift Aid

If you are a taxpayer, you can increase your donations to Sacred Heart by 25%, simply by completing a Gift Aid Declaration (GAD). You only need to do this once.

Through the Gift Aid scheme, the government gives the church 25p for every £1 you donate. What the church receives is tax you have already paid. **It costs you no more.** To be able to claim that 25p for every £1 you donate, the church needs to keep a record of how much is donated by each Gift Aider. All tax payers are encouraged to make their donations under gift aid and the information you provide is in the strictest confidence. There are a few options available to make your donations under gift aid.

Single Donations under Gift Aid

If you wish to make a single gift aided donation by cash or cheque, please use the envelopes available at the back of church for single donations. Alternatively, if you wish to make a single gift aided donation by debit or credit card please use the Tap to Donate tablet at the back of church and choose to gift aid your donation. This method may also be used for regular donations by using the tablet each time you wish to donate.

Regular Donations under Gift Aid

If you wish to make regular gift aided donations (e.g. weekly or monthly) by standing order, cheque or offertory envelope please complete a Gift Aid Declaration (GAD) form which is available at the

back of church.

Please note that you may choose the following donation options on the form:

- a) "past 4 years", which enables the parish to claim for previous as well as future donations;
- b) "future donations", which enables the parish to claim for future donations. Please do not select "today" since this is for one-off donations rather than regular donations.

You may also choose to make your donations by:

- a) Standing order - this is the preferred option since your donation is transferred directly from your bank account to the parish bank account.
- b) Cheque
- c) NE (offertory envelope)

Please ensure the form is signed and dated and hand your completed GAD to Fr. Michael or leave it at the presbytery.

Once you have completed your form, if you selected to pay by standing order, please set up a standing order with your bank for the regular amount you wish to donate. This can usually be done via online banking or via a banking app or by visiting your bank.

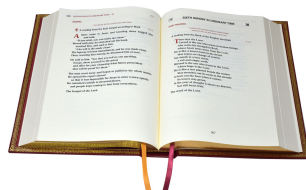
Preparation for Confirmation 2025

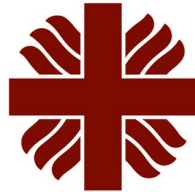
Online parent information session is Wednesday 29 January at 7pm. Candidate sessions are starting Saturday 8 February 1-4pm in the presbytery.

Attention to new Readers of the Word of God

If you missed the November training for existing Readers or you are a new Reader then you are invited to a training session for new readers in the Church on Saturday 1 March from 10.00 until 12.00 noon. This will include an introduction to the Liturgy of the Word at Mass, the practical skills required for reading in church, use of the sound system, and an introduction to the new Lectionary and Bible translation. This will equip parish readers to more effectively proclaim the texts they read. If you love the Word of God and are confident in reading aloud in public then come along, undertake a short training session, and add your name to the roster for the Masses you normally attend.



Caritas Internationalis - Turn debt into hope

Following Pope Francis's invitation letter to mark the 2025 Jubilee, *Spes Non Confundit* ("Hope does not disappoint", Rom 5:5), we are pleased to announce that Caritas Internationalis has launched a year-long global initiative: **the Caritas's Jubilee debt campaign, "Turn Debt into Hope"**, to demand debt justice for communities crushed by unjust and unpayable debts.

The **Holy Father** endorsed Caritas's campaign on 26th December 2024 by saying: **"One of the actions that characterises Jubilees is the forgiving of debts. I therefore encourage everyone to support the Caritas Internationalis campaign** entitled 'Turn Debt into Hope', to relieve countries oppressed by unsustainable debts and to promote development."

Unsustainable and unjust public debts deprive nations of the resources needed to invest in health, education, climate action and the futures of their young people, locking entire generations into **cycles of poverty and inequality**. The International Monetary Fund (IMF) calculates that, of 68 low-income countries, 9 are in debt distress and 51 are at high risk of debt distress. The United Nations reports that 19 low-income countries spend more on debt interest than on education, and 45 spend more on debt interest than on health.

"It is certainly possible to restructure the debt, but at the price of increasing poverty," says Professor Stefano Zamagni, President of the Pontifical Academy of Social Sciences. For example, **Zambia's debt restructuring has pushed its poverty rate to 60%**, an "unacceptable trade-off, both ethically and politically."
