Sick and Retired Clergy

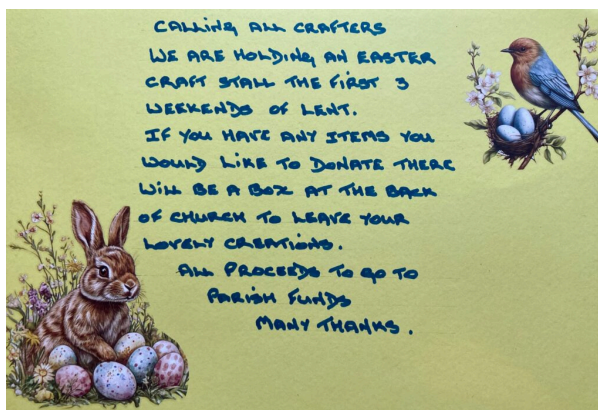
Each year, the Diocese has instructed parishes to have 2 collections to support our sick and retired clergy. I think we are all very much aware that there is an aging population of priests in the Diocese

and each year more money is needed for their upkeep. In recent years, the collections in parishes have not raised enough to cover the fund needed and as a consequence, the Diocese has now directed the amount each parish needs to contribute each year. The levy for our parish is £4,145 and currently we have raised £367.38. The balance of £3,777.62 is due to be paid by June 29th 2025. So, we will need to raise some funds. We will have a further collection and there is now a button on the tablet and the website so that money can be donated for this fund at any time. In its general description, 'Retired and Sick Clergy' may not mean a great deal but if we think of our own Fr Shaun Smith who has been retired for almost 7 years, it gives us a context to work with. How would Fr Shaun manage without the support of this fund? Any ideas for fundraising would be welcomed. Many thanks in anticipation of your generosity.

Christian Life Community

"Christian Life Community (CLC) is for people who want to understand more deeply how God is at work in their everyday lives. We meet regularly in small (house) groups to pray and share, supporting one another through the ups and downs of ordinary life. In listening to one another we grow to understand ourselves, deepen our relationship with God and discover more clearly how each one of us is uniquely called to respond to God's love."

CLC is a way of life inspired by the spirituality of St Ignatius. We embrace this way of life as a means of enabling us to bring together our faith and our lives so that we are aware of God working in every aspect of them. Some of us come to CLC without any prior experience of Ignatian spirituality; others come after discovering Ignatian spirituality in various ways, such as weeks of guided prayer or retreats.

There are three main aspects of CLC:

- Living Prayer – making time, preferably daily, to spend time in prayer. This can be as little as 5 or 10 minutes.
- Sharing Community – in the CLC meetings each person shares how God has been and is at work for them. We are a spiritual family and support each other and encourage perseverance in deepening in our union with God.
- Loving Service – we are companions of Christ in the mission to establish God wherever we live and work.

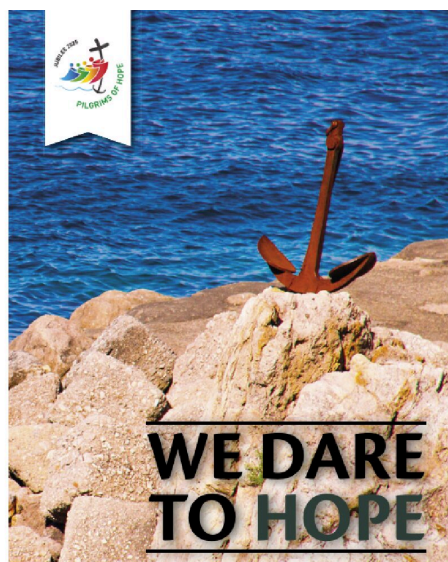

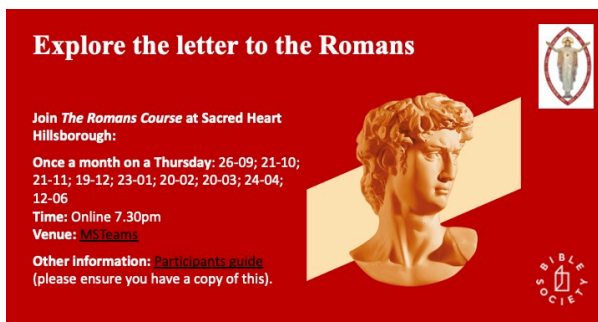
