Hello friends, I am sharing this weekend's notice in St. Vincent's bulletin about a short pilgrimage we are organising for Monday September 1st from St. Michael's, Rivelin, to Sacred Heart Church Hillsborough. Father Walsh offers Mass at St. Michael's on the first Monday of each month for the souls of those buried there and in Crookes Cemetery. The next September Mass will also herald the Season of Creation (September 1st to October 4th) and St. Michael's is a beautiful setting to hear Mass and honour the day. Anyone from neighbouring parishes would be most welcome to join us for the Mass and an easy walk afterwards along the Rivelin Valley.
