Pilgrimage for Peace – To Commemorate the 800th Anniversary of St Francis of Assisi

Please join us for this important Parish event on Saturday, 10th October. We will walk for approximately 4 and a half miles along Rivelin Valley and return for Mass in St Michael's Chapel in Rivelin Cemetery. The itinerary is as follows:

- At 9.30 a.m meet at Sacred Heart Church to begin the walk
- At 10a.m. We will assemble at Rivelin Cafe for any pilgrims joining there
- At 12p.m. We will meet for Mass at St Michael's Chapel in Rivelin Cemetery

Although the route is flat SENSIBLE / STURDY SHOES are a must as the paths are sometimes uneven and the terrain is not suitable for prams or pushchairs. Please bring your own snacks and water.

In our very troubled world, this pilgrimage is an opportunity for us to come together as a faith community and Walk and Pray for Peace.

Sacred Heart Parish - Camino de Santiago Walk

Our parish hopes to arrange a pilgrim walk along the Camino de Santiago, from 7 to 14 June 2027, along the ancient route from Ferrol to Santiago de Compostela.

This proposed pilgrimage offers time for prayer, reflection and companionship, enjoying the views of the countryside, the sea and historical sites.

It is one of the most important pilgrimage routes dating back to the 9th century.

The pilgrimage leads to the shrine of the Apostle James in the cathedral of Santiago de Compostela in Spain, where he is venerated.

It became a major medieval pilgrimage route and is one of the "three great pilgrimages of Christendom" alongside Jerusalem and Rome.

The Camino is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, recognized for its cultural importance.

It passes through historic villages, churches, and landscapes shaped by centuries of pilgrim stories.

The walk attracts people from all over the world, of different ages and beliefs.

Its 120 km (75 miles) on foot, with consecutive days of multi-hour walking, between four and seven hours per day, on varied terrain so you need to be relatively fit and able.

The intended package will include:

1. Private rooms with en-suite bathrooms at each location
2. Daily luggage transfer (1x20kg bag each person)
3. Official pilgrim's credentials/app access
4. Half board, breakfast and dinner

The plans for the trip are purely in the exploratory stage at present.

A rough guide for a party of 20 is a sum of £1,400.00 per person, but this is of course subject to change.
